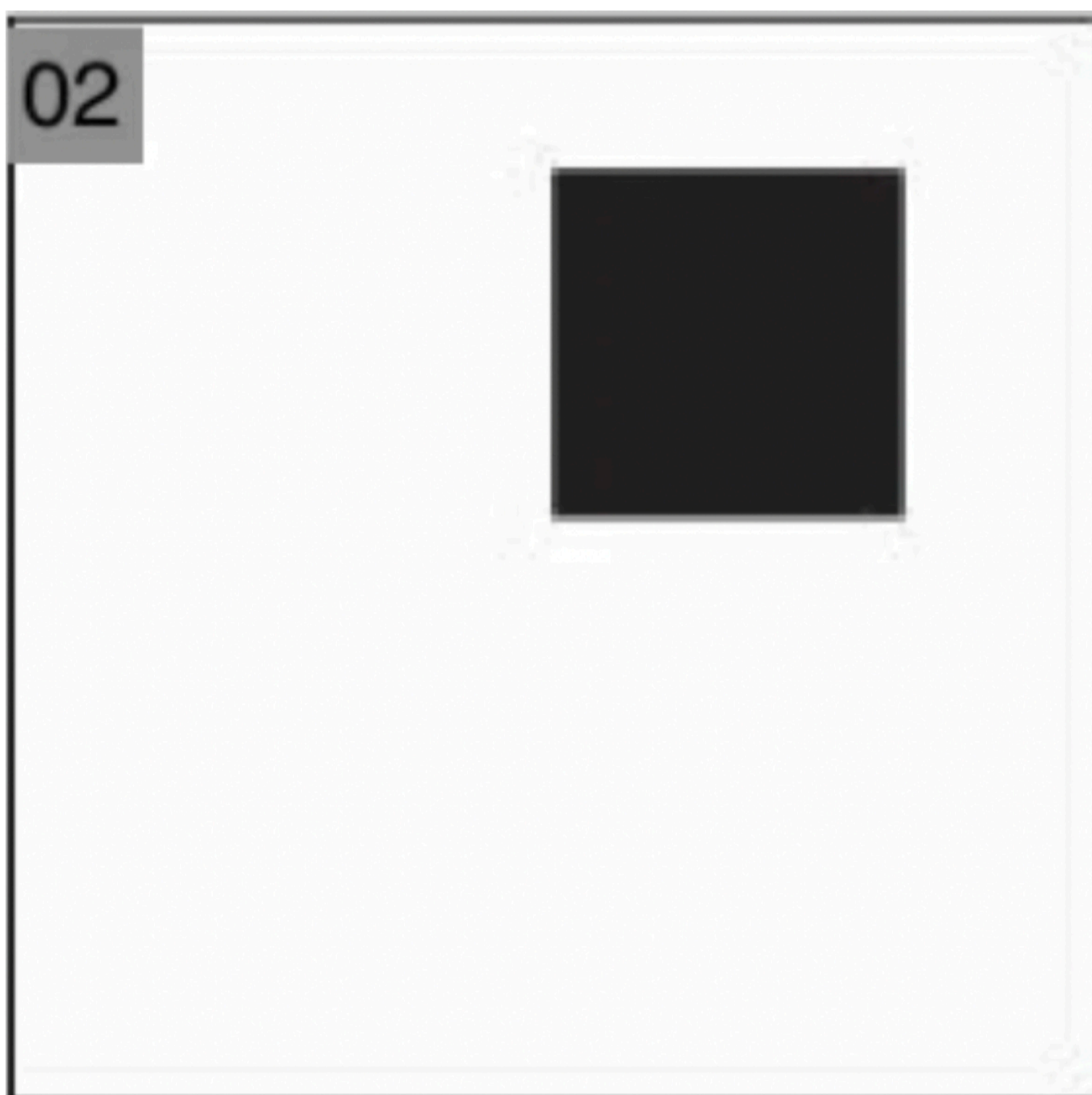
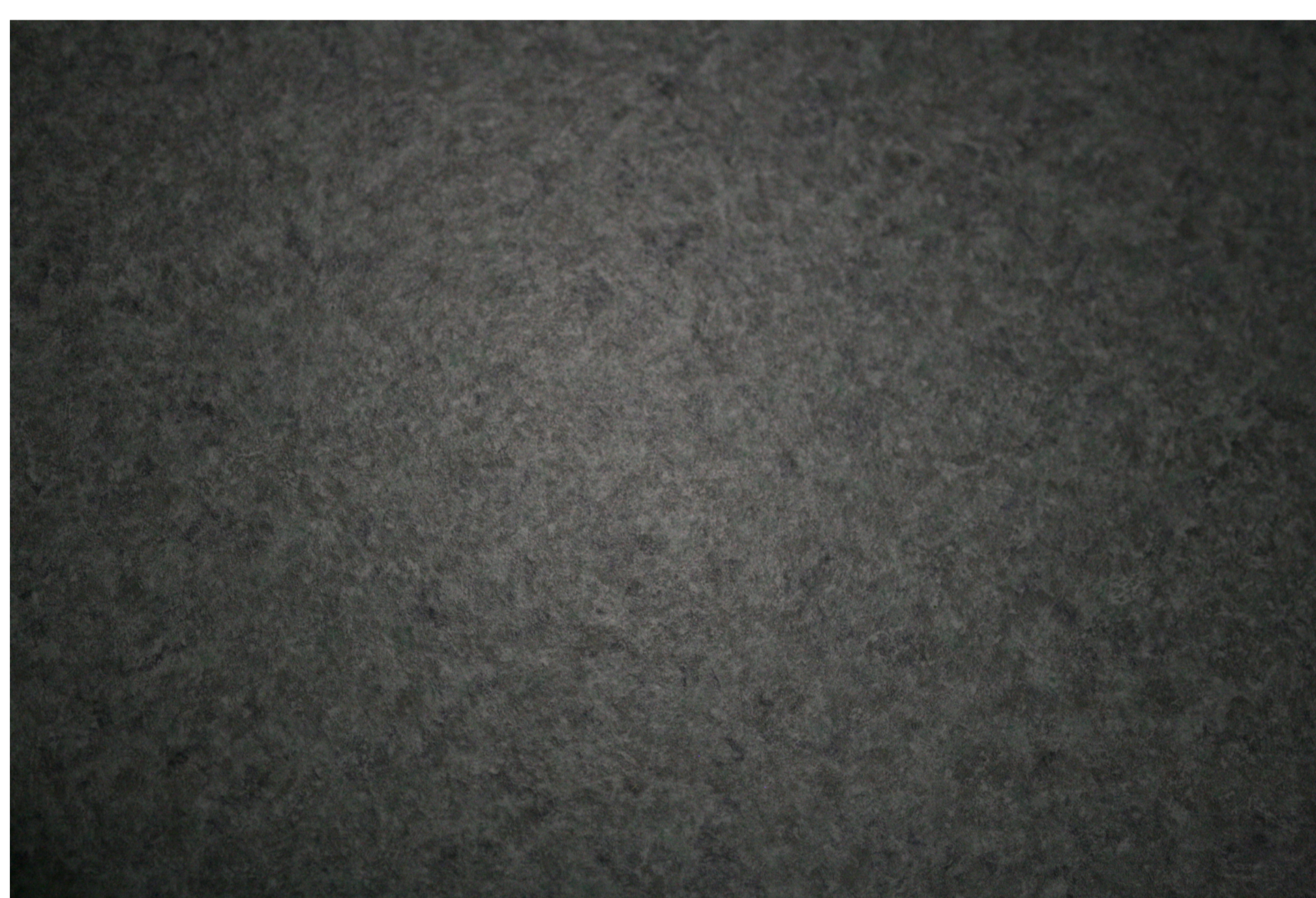
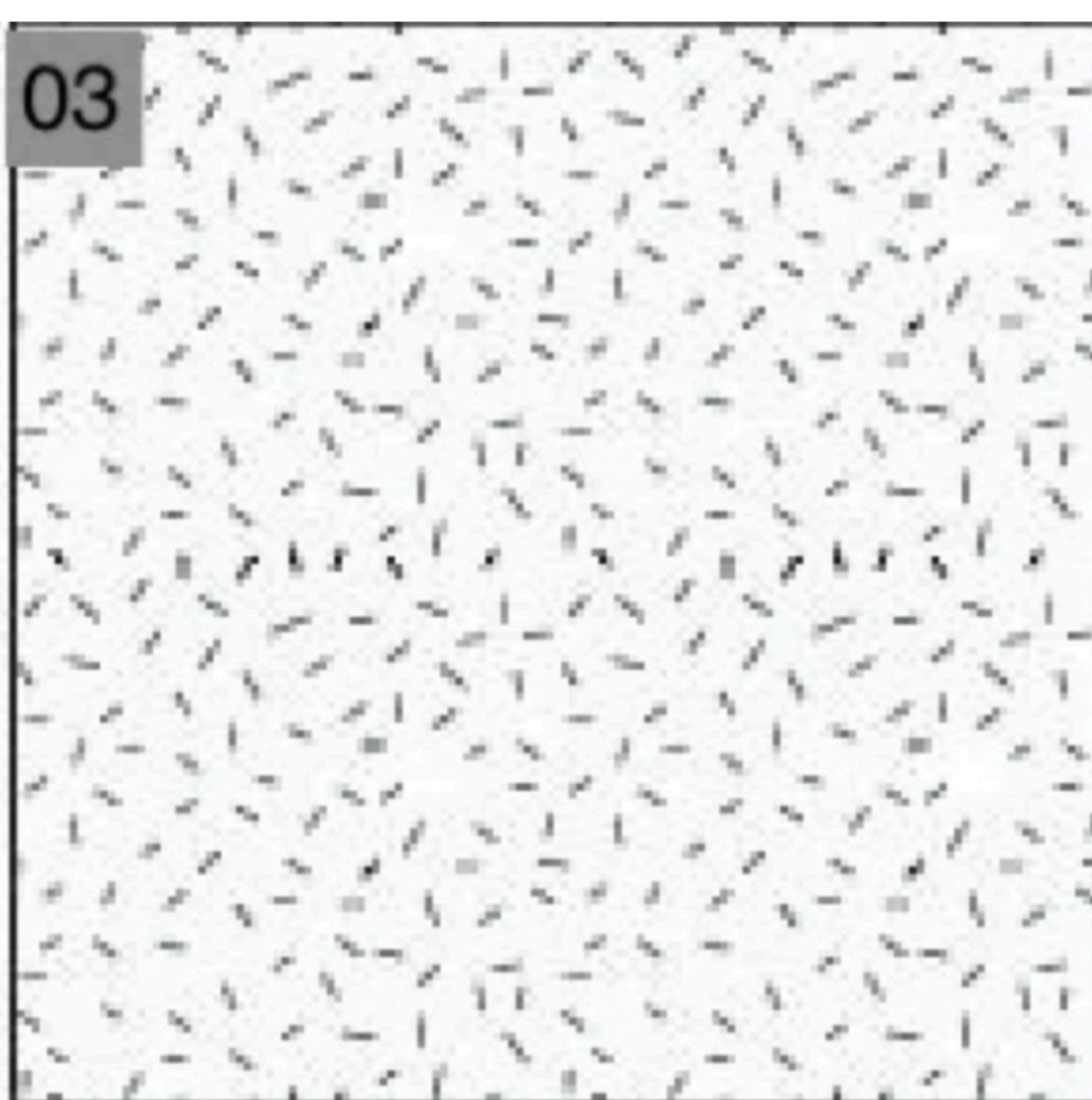




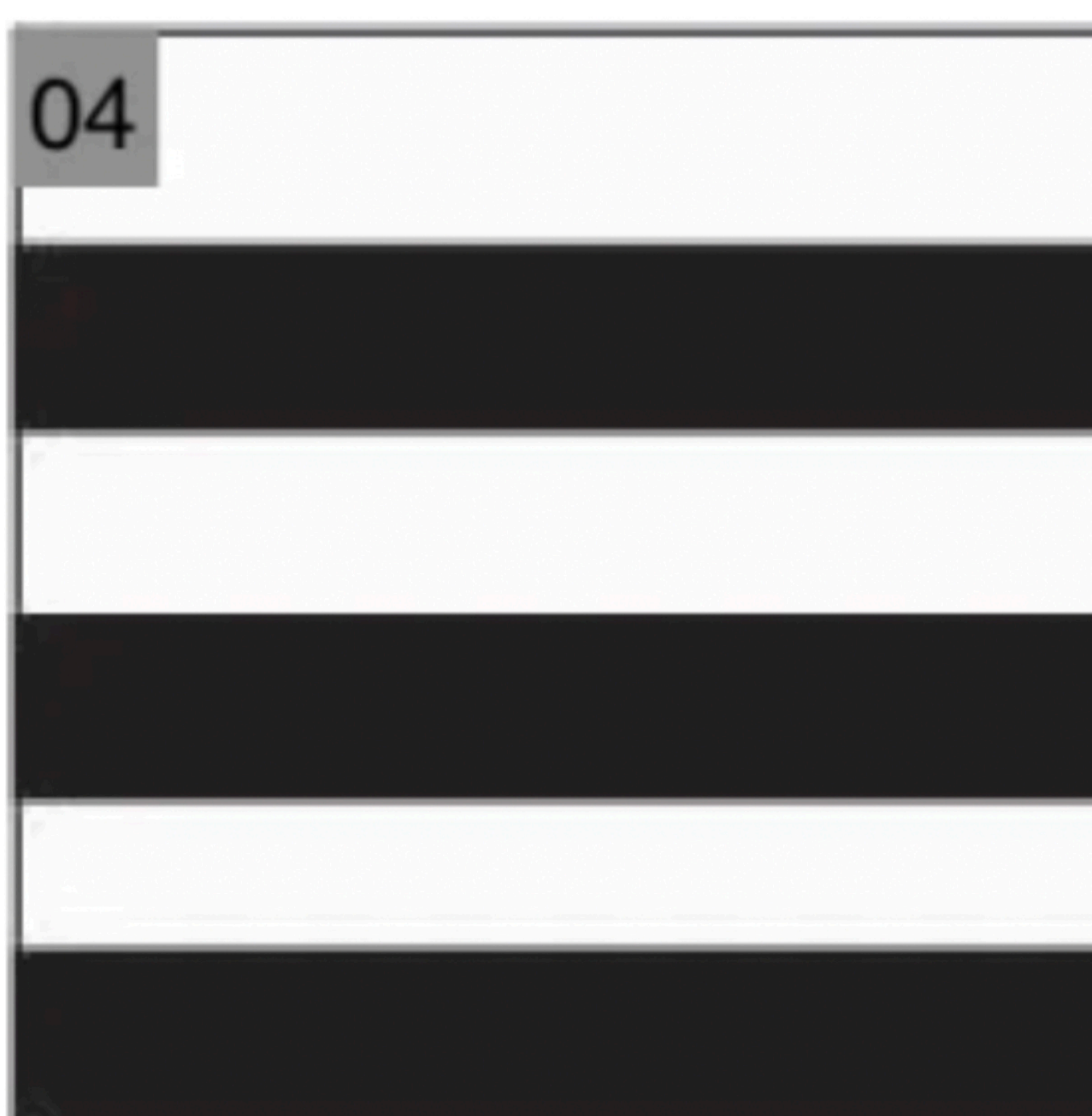
A rectangular white pillar and the maroon wall behind it. The photo showed both color and shape.



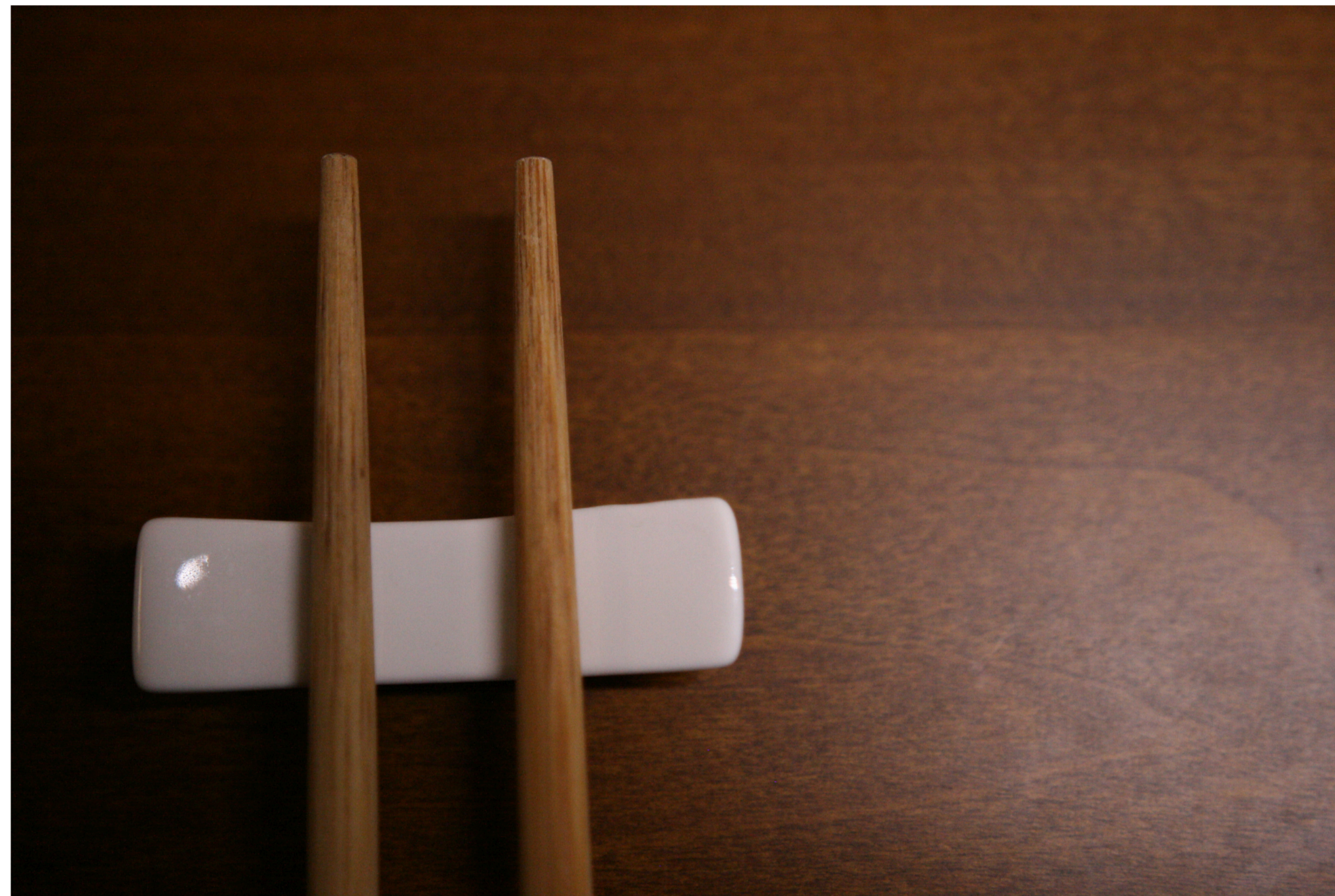

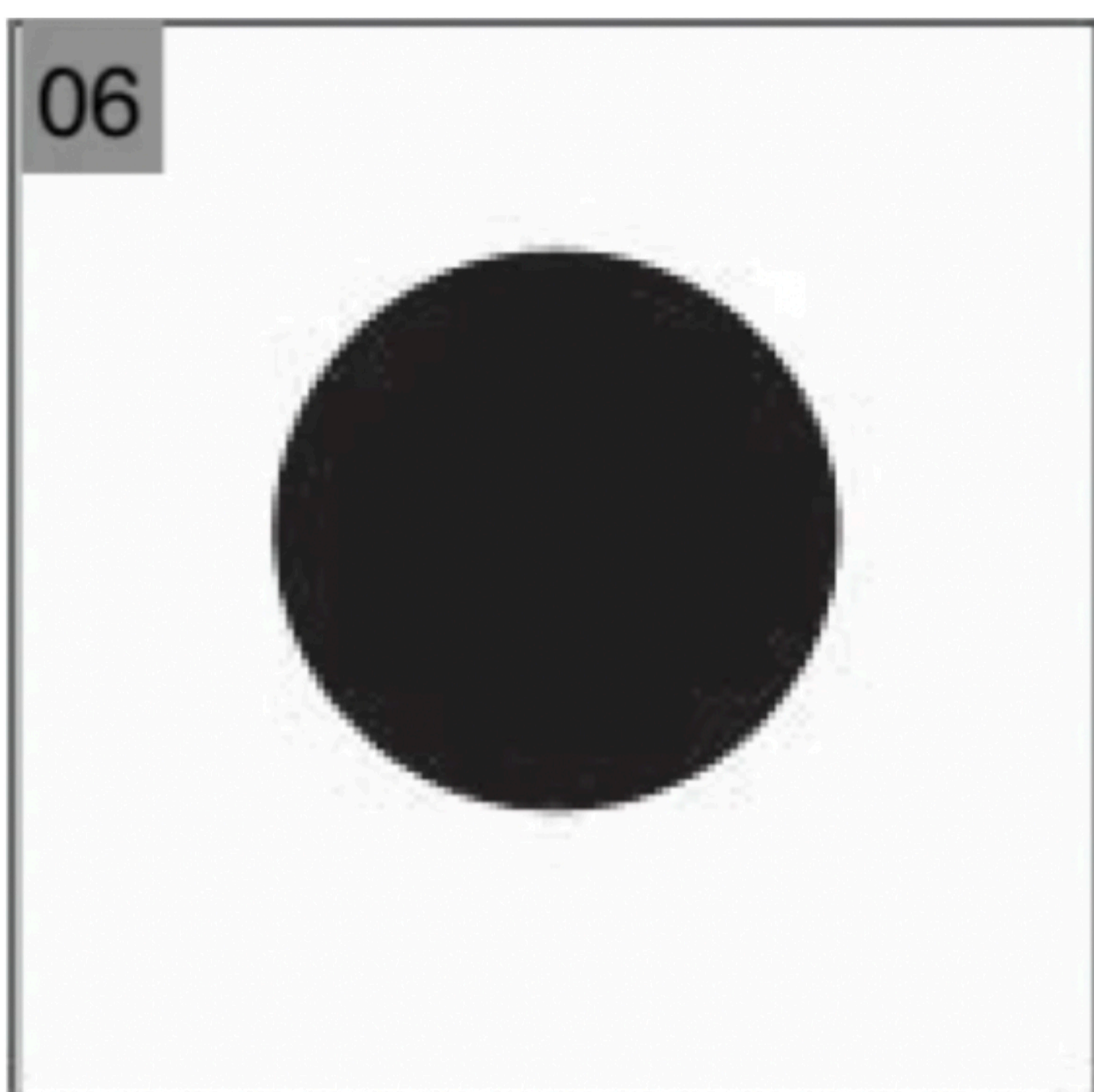
The gray mosaic-patterned tiles. The grainy pattern of the tile gives the photo a unique texture.



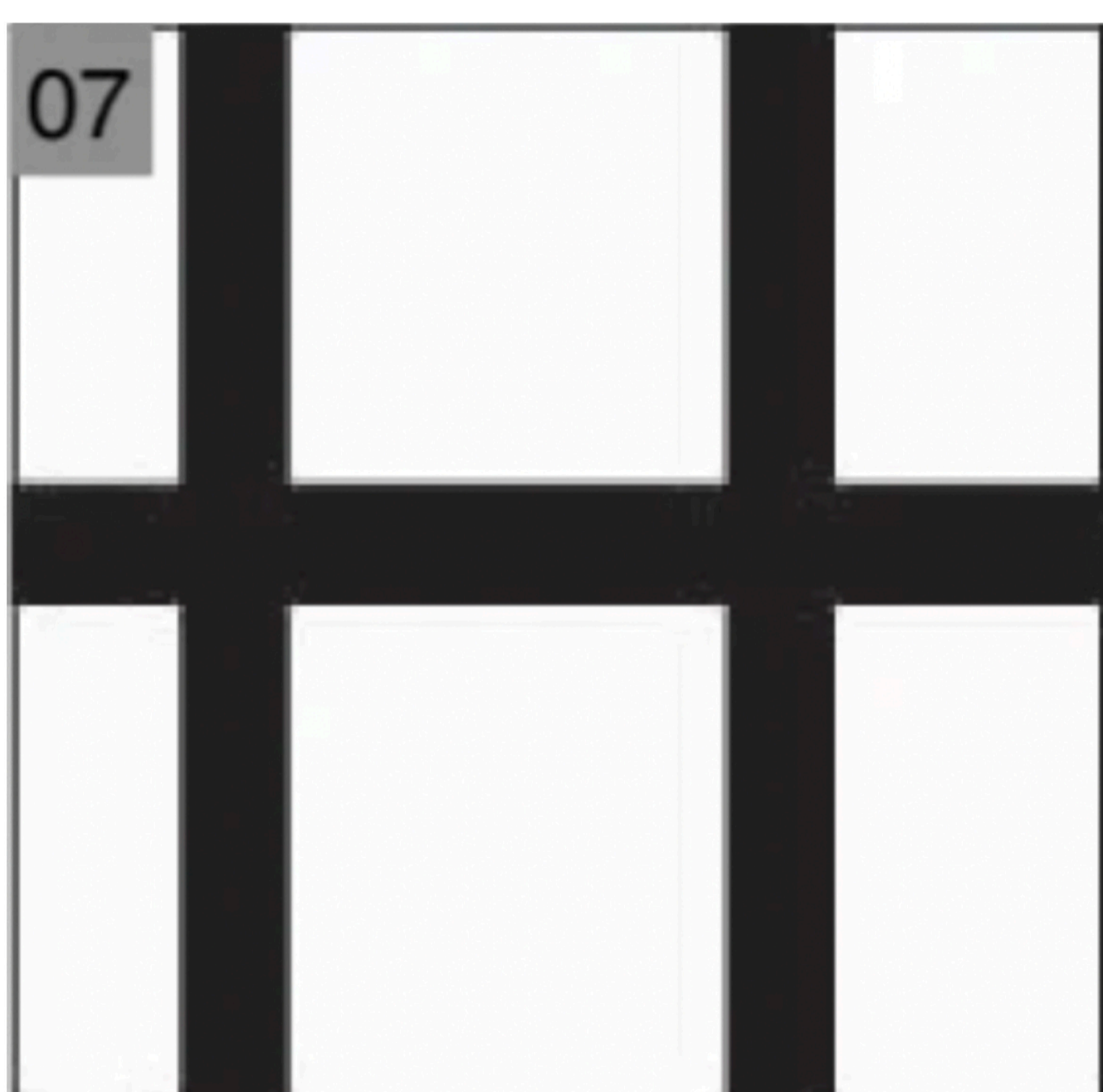
The folds of an air conditioner. The photo shows horizontal lines that form patterns



A pair of wooden chopsticks sitting on a chopstick-holder on top of a wooden table. This picture shows line, shape, and value.



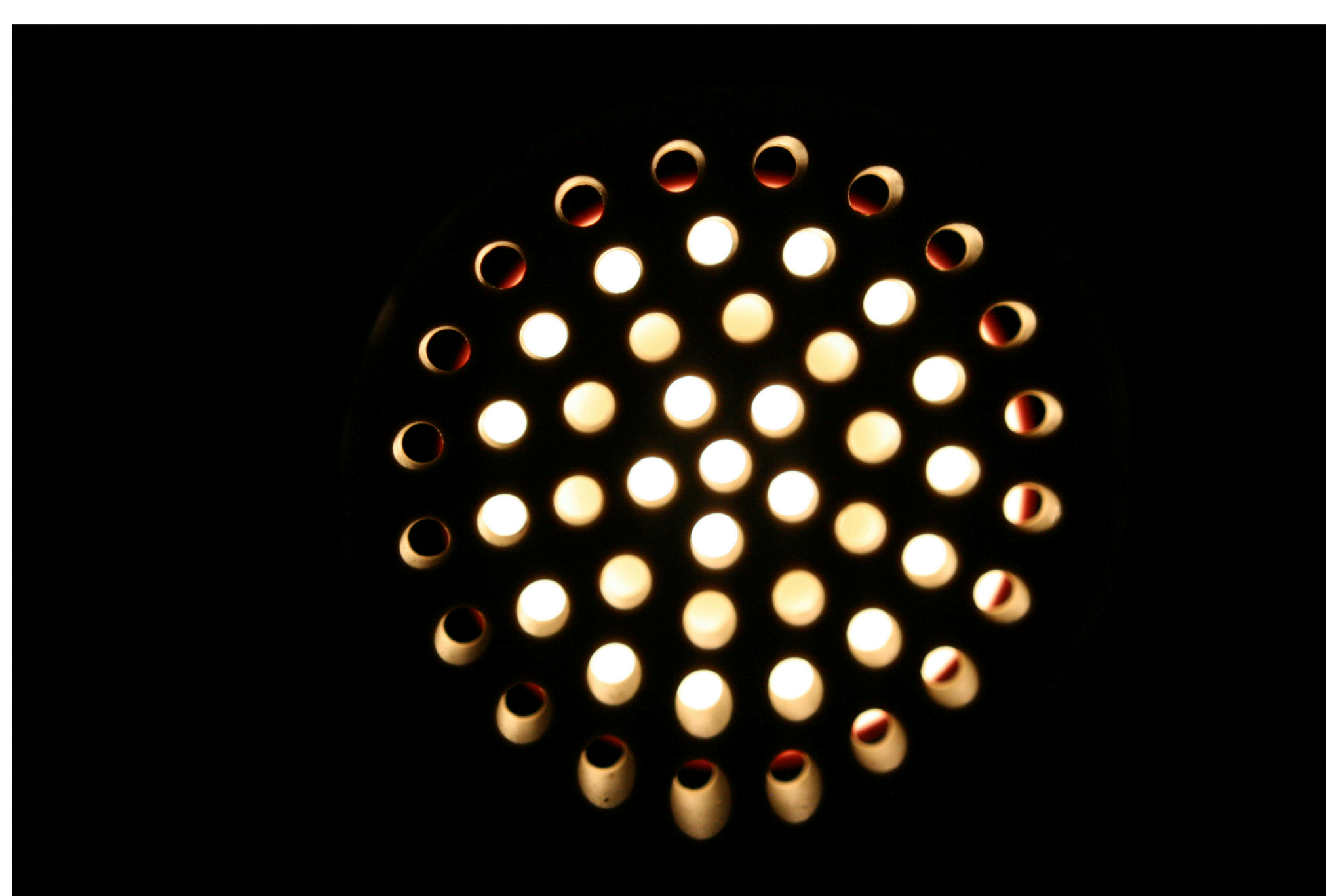
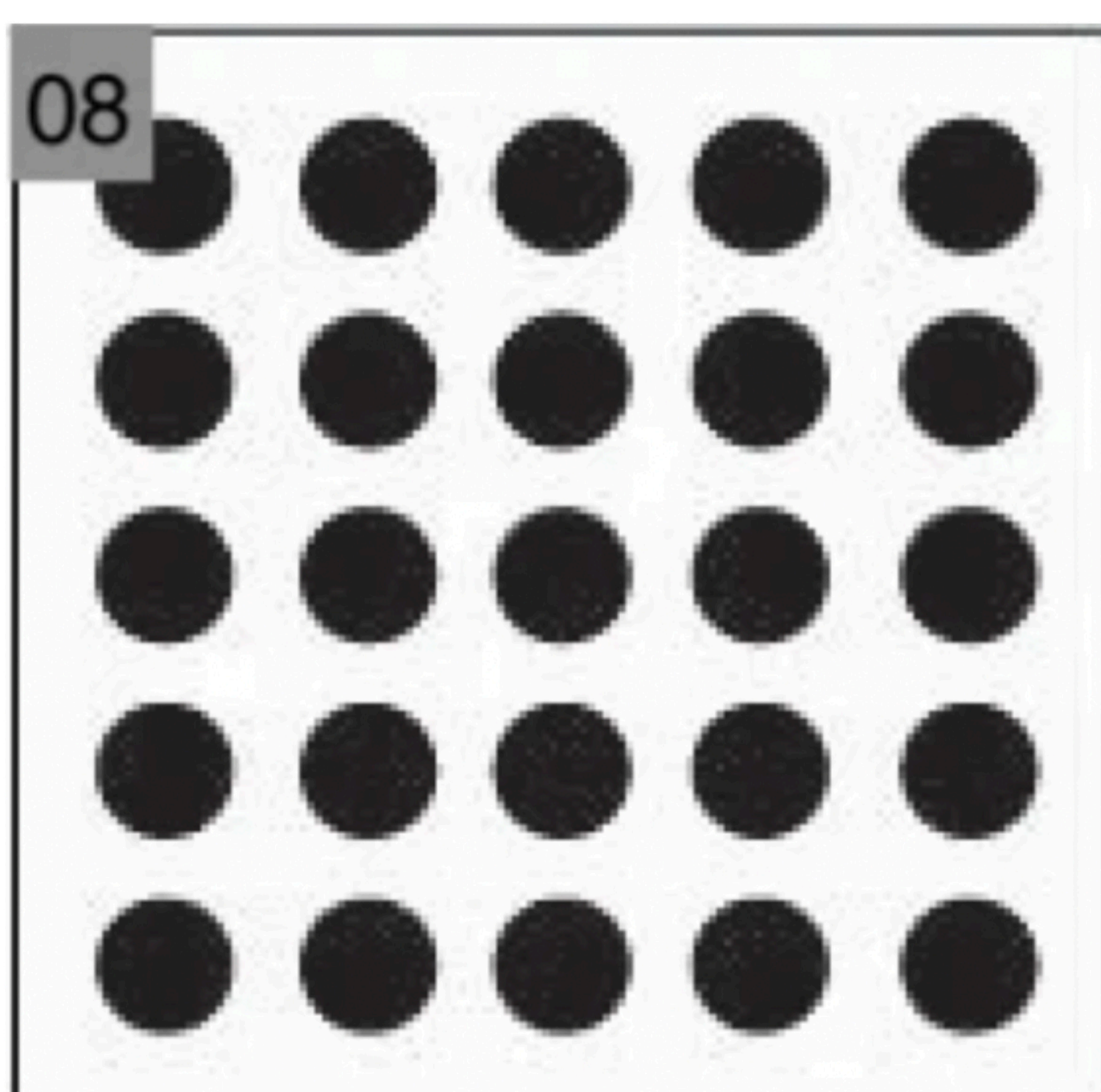
Looking directly into a lamp. This photo shows shape, color, and value.



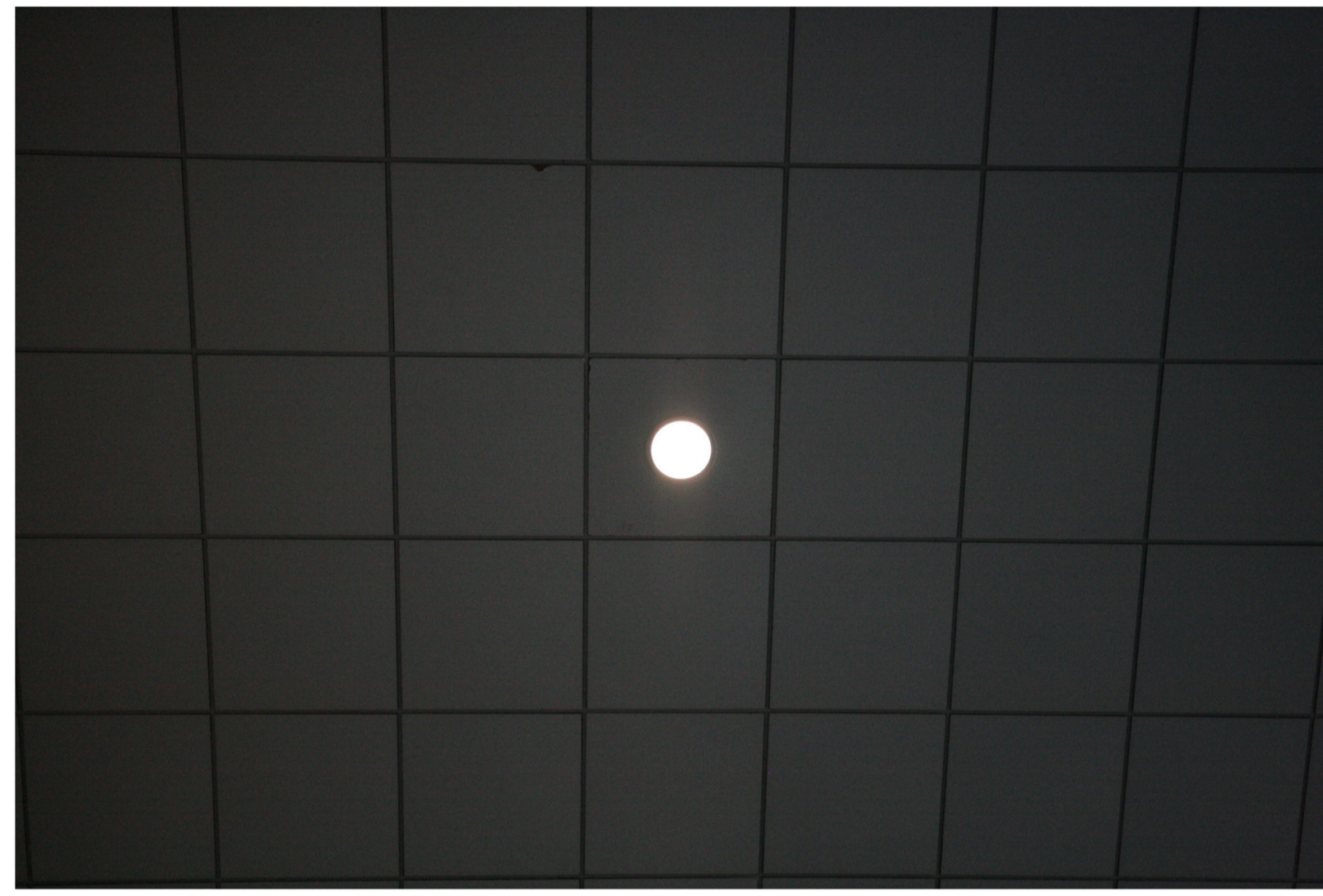
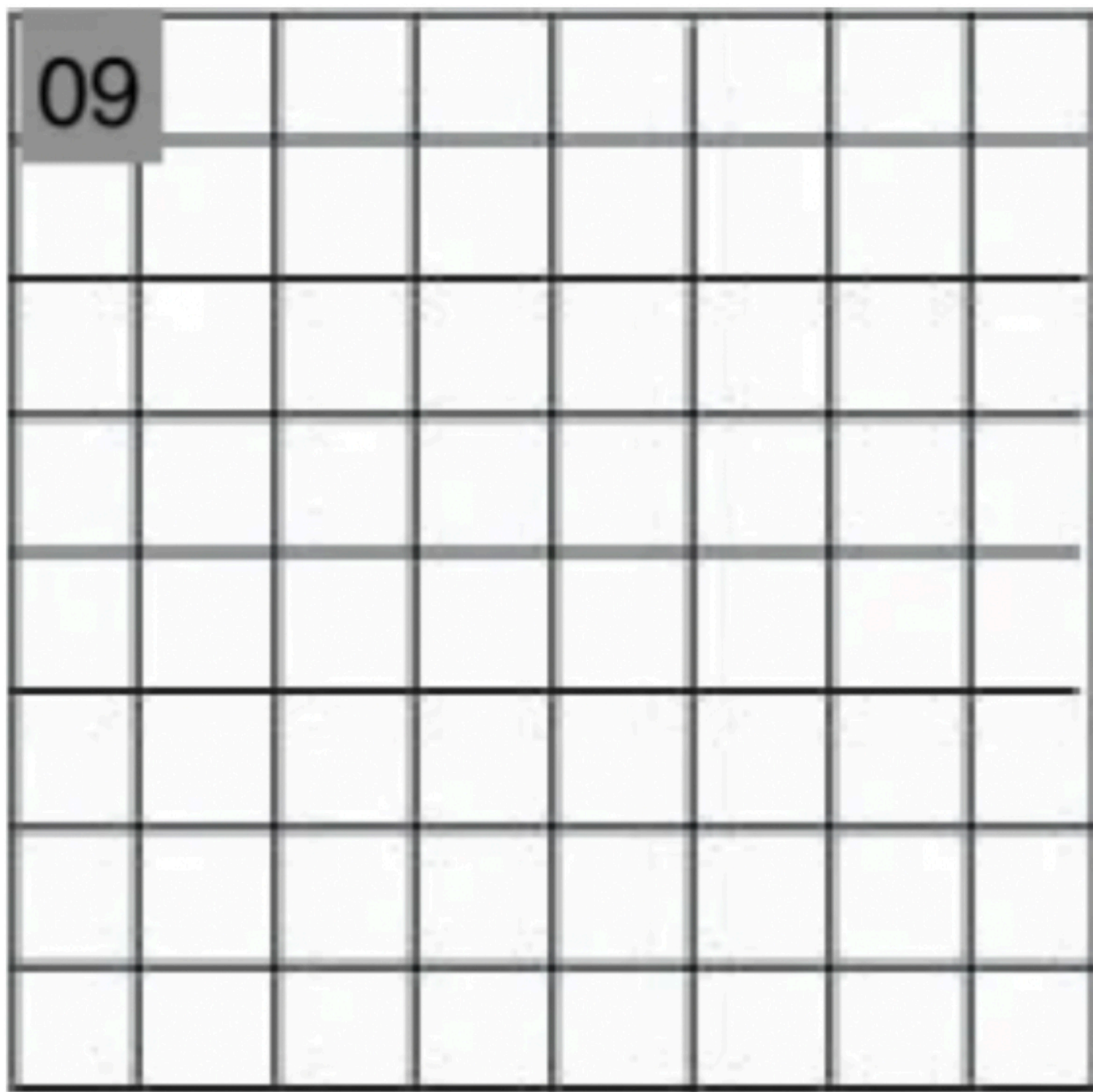
Design studio ceiling lights organized in grids. This picture shows lines, shapes, and value.



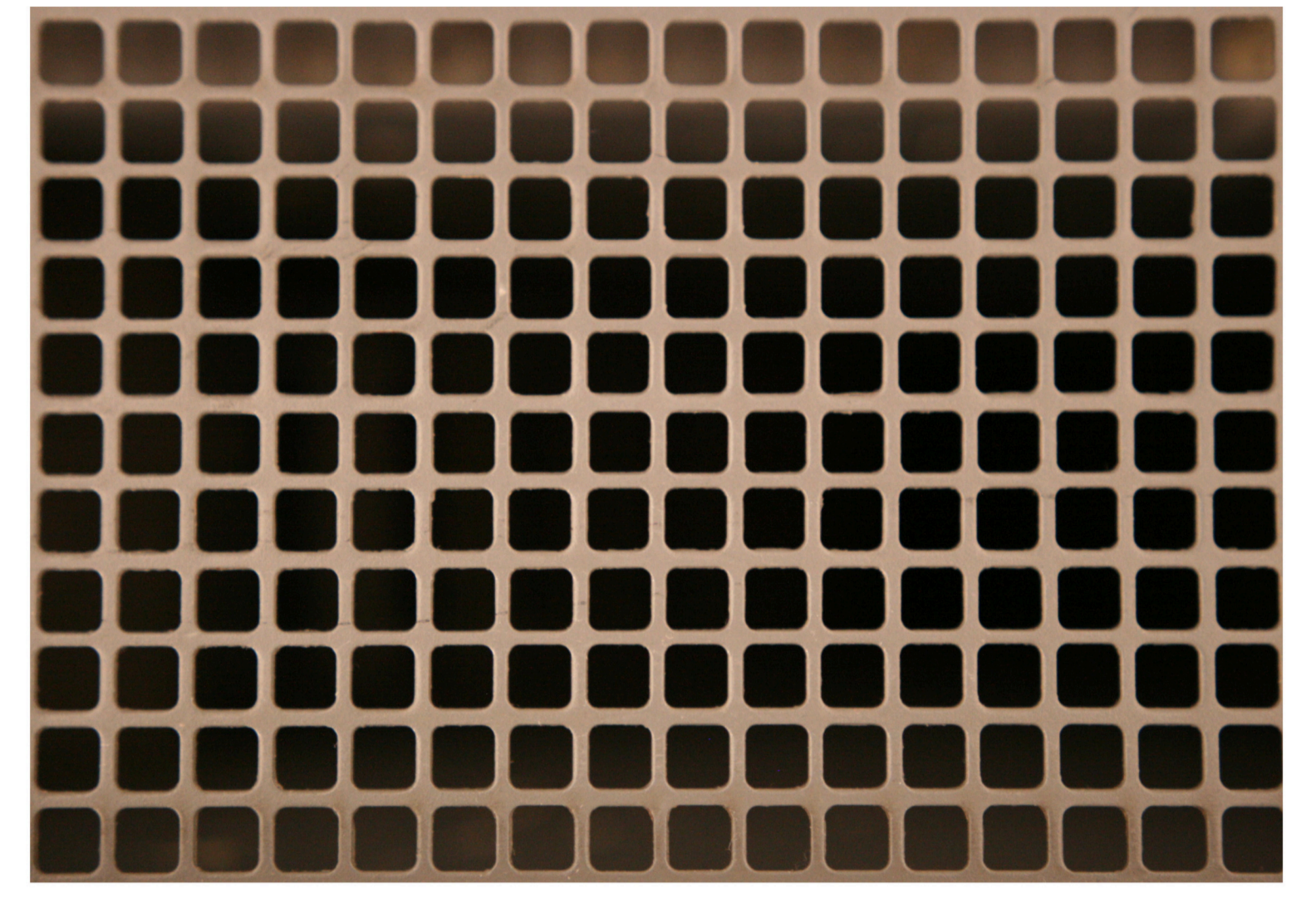
Window divided into large rectangles. This picture shows lines and shapes.



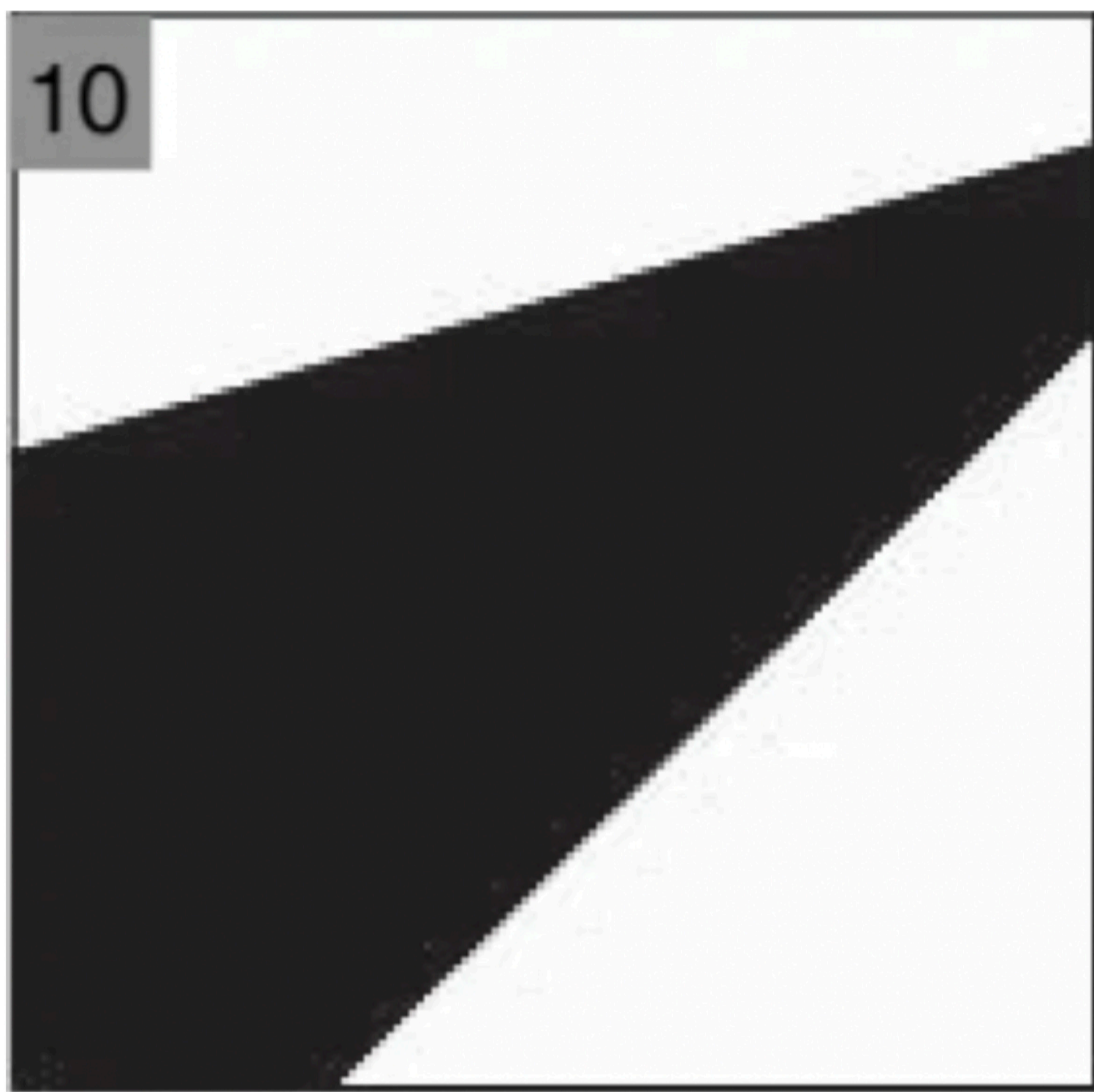

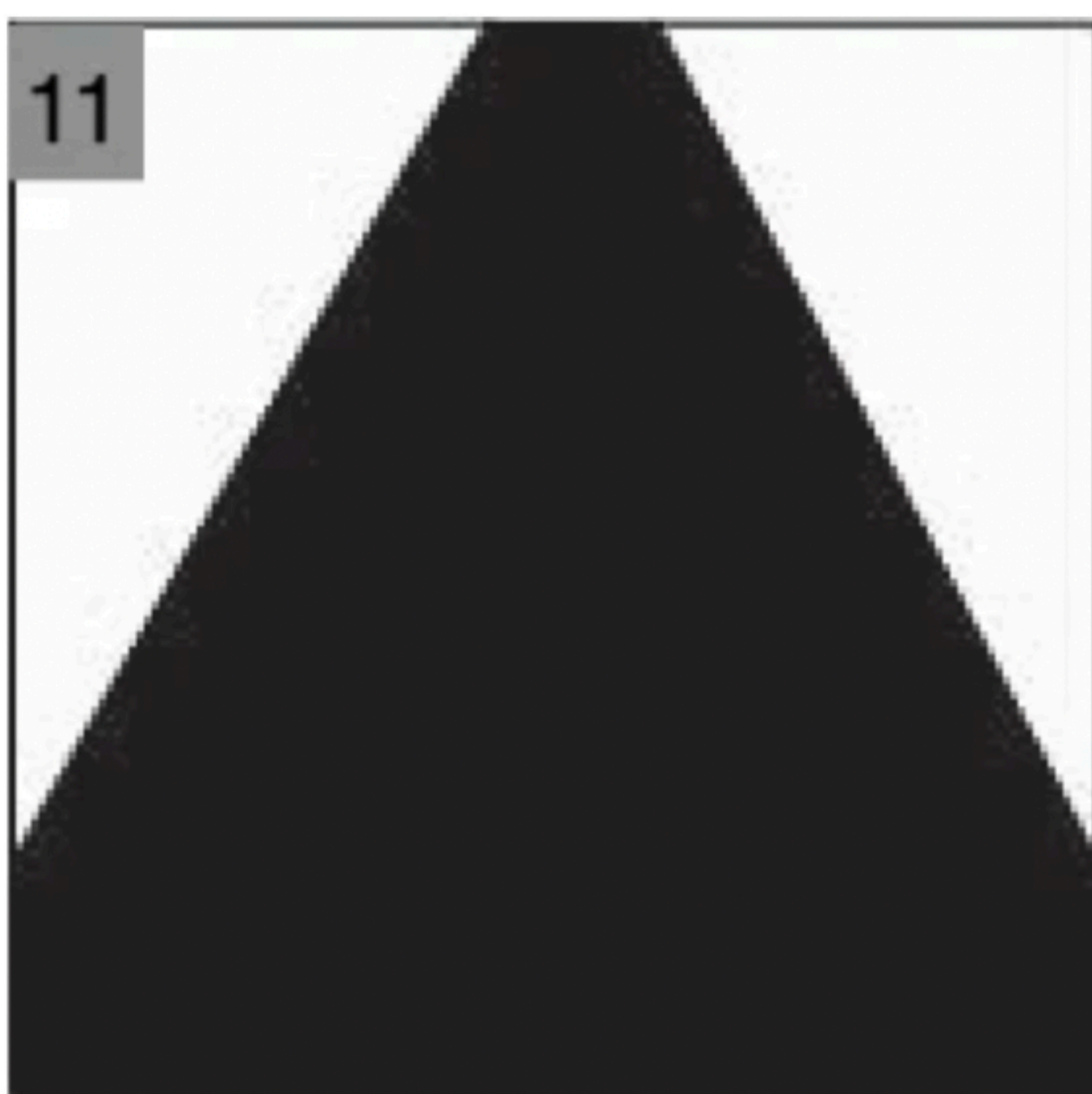
Gridded ceiling tiles with a light in the middle. This photo shows line, shape, pattern, and value.



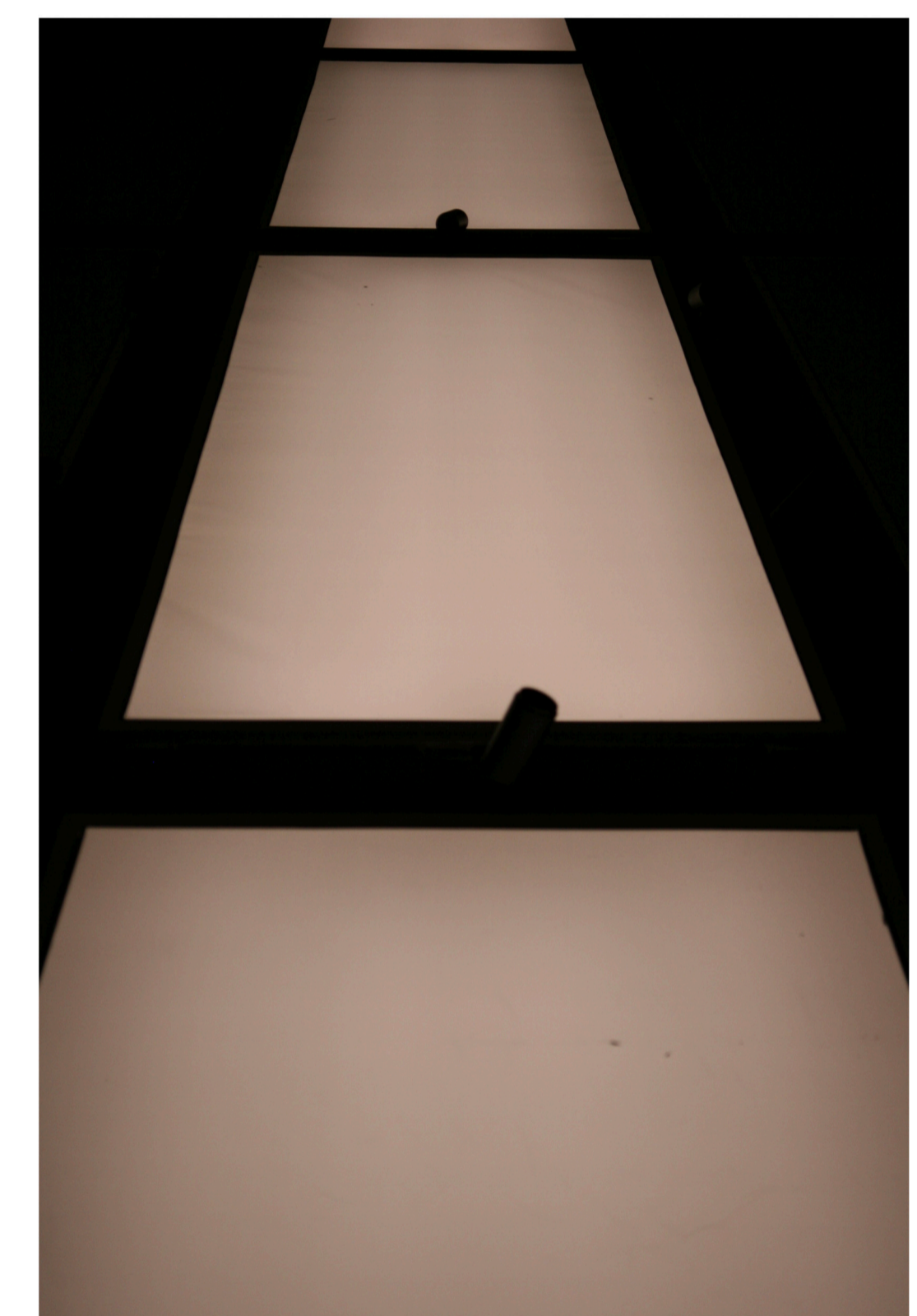
The filter of a BlueAir air conditioner. This photo shows shape and pattern.



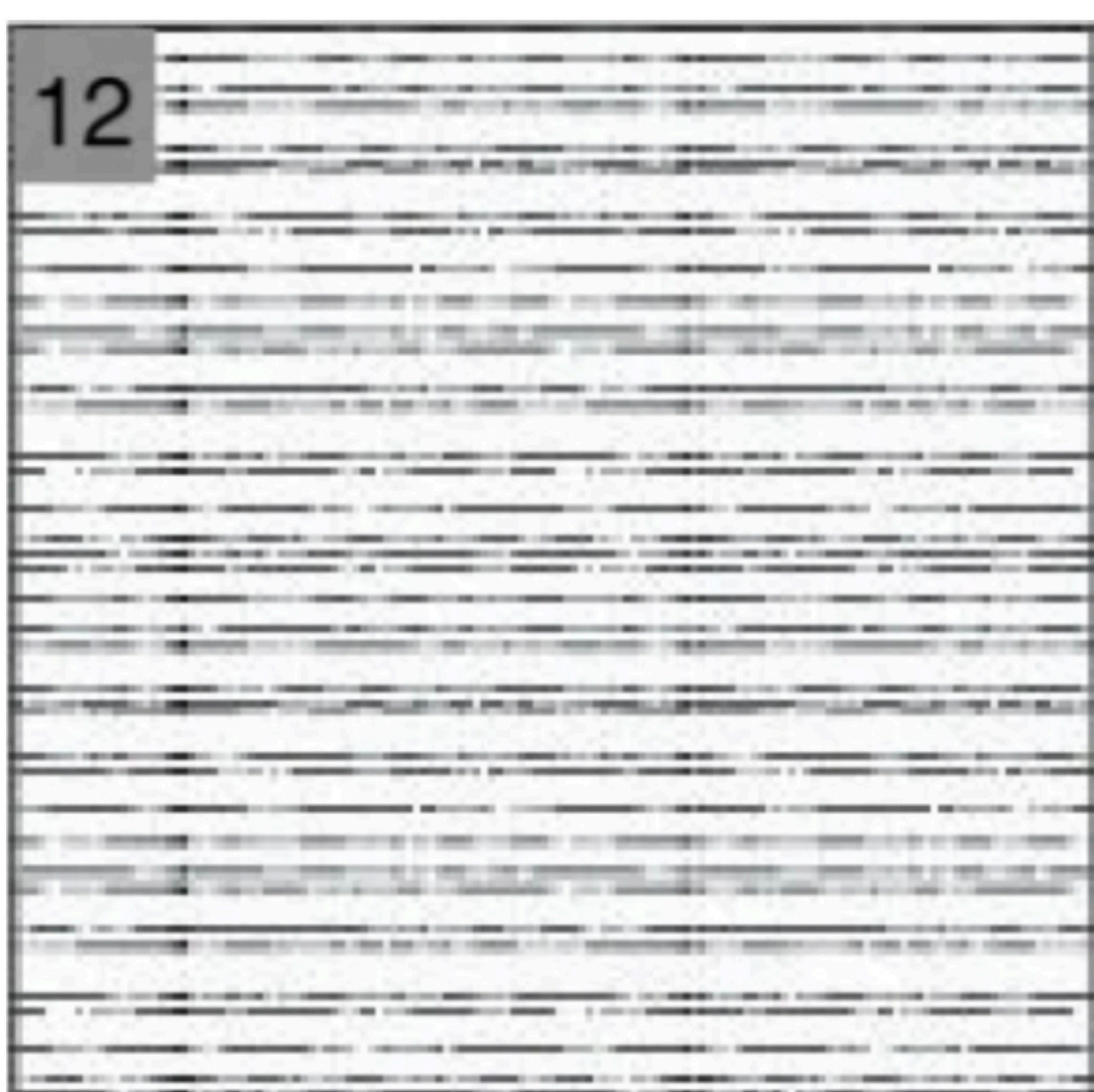
Chinese new year dragon. This picture shows texture, color, and depth.
