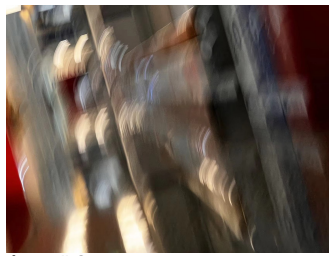


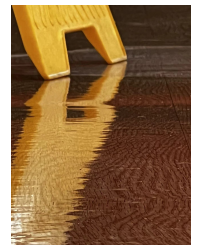
**photo # 1**  
This photo breaks the rules because the subject is not in focus, the whole photo is very blurry.



**photo # 2**

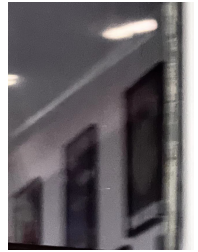
**photo # 5**
