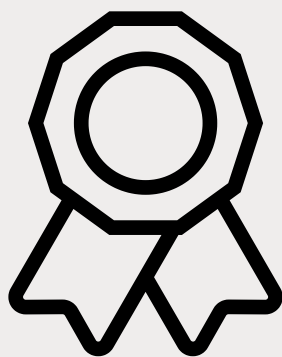


MY SELF AS A HUMANIST

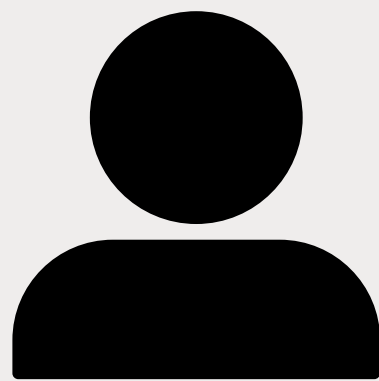
1. PRIZED INDIVIDUAL
